The winners will be announced on Oct 26th & 27th. The contest will consist of 3 different age groups. Further details and decorating information will be sent home on a Pumpkin Contest entry form.



Show and Tell: We will be having Show and Tell every Thursday (for TT students) and every Friday (for MWF students) throughout the months of October and November. We ask that your child bring in something that goes along with our lesson/letter of the week. For example: If we are learning

about the letter C; a cat, car, or cow would be great toys to bring in and share. This is a way of helping the children with letter-sound recognition and to open up and feel comfortable talking to, and in front of, the teachers and other children.

Fire Prevention Week: We will be teaching Fire Prevention and Safety October 4th -8th. We will be discussing fire safety and 911 emergency procedures. We will also have a practice fire drill at



school and have the children practice stop, drop, and roll. We are hoping to get a local fire department to come to our school, talk to the children, and bring along their equipment and fire trucks. The fire fighters we have gotten to come in the past may not come this year due to covid because of their new rules and regulations, which we understand completely. We are hoping to find another station to come and put on a demonstration for our kiddos in the event that they are unable to come because students in the past have always loved the visit from the fire fighters! If we are able to find someone we will be sending home a flyer at a later date with more information and details.



Columbus Day: School will be closed on Monday, October 11th in observance of Columbus day.

Harvest Party and Parade: Our Harvest Party will be held on Thursday, Oct 28th for our TT class and Friday, Oct 29th for our MWF classes. All children should come to school dressed in their costumes. All parents are welcome to come and watch the parade. The TT class parade will begin at 11:30. The MWF AM class parade will begin at 11:00 and the MWF PM class parade will begin at 2:30.
