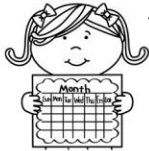

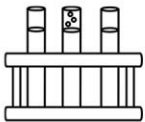

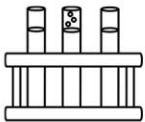
## A Note From Mrs. Shroyer and Mrs. Shultz
